- 1. **F (D):** This symbol denotes "Marginal Failed (D)". It signifies that the candidate's performance was below the passing threshold, yet within a close margin of passing. Despite falling short of a passing grade, this designation acknowledges a near achievement.
- 2. **F (E):** Representing "Failed (E)" this symbol indicates that the candidate's performance was below the passing threshold by higher margin as compared to F (D). It denotes a failing grade but acknowledges some degree of attainment within the specified range.
- 3. **Ungraded:** This status is assigned to candidates whose performance falls below a certain threshold. It indicates that the candidate's performance was significantly below the passing threshold and does not qualify for even a failed graded result. Candidates receiving this status may require further improvement or remedial action before reattempting the assessment.
